

William Giannobile, D.D.S., D.Med.Sc.

Dr. William Giannobile is the Najjar Endowed Professor & Chair of the Department of Periodontics and Oral Medicine at the University of Michigan School of Dentistry. He is also a Professor of Biomedical Engineering at the College of Engineering. He received his DDS and MS in Oral Biology from the University of Missouri. He later received his Certificate in Periodontology and Doctor of Medical Sciences in Oral Biology from Harvard University. He subsequently completed postdoctoral training in Molecular Biology at the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute and Harvard Medical School. Dr. Giannobile previously served as a faculty member at Harvard and the Forsyth Institute. He has served as a Visiting Professor at the Biotechnology Institute of Regenerative Medicine at the University of Genoa Medical School in Genoa, Italy in 2006 and in 2013 as a Visiting Professor in the Department of Periodontology at the Eastman Dental Institute, University College London.

Dr. Giannobile has lectured extensively in the area of Periodontal Regenerative Medicine, Tissue Engineering and Personalized Medicine. Dr. Giannobile currently serves as the Editor-in-Chief for the *Journal of Dental Research*. He has edited textbooks on clinical research, periodontal regeneration and translational research. He is a past president of the American Academy of Periodontology Foundation. Dr. Giannobile is a consultant to the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for Dental Devices. Dr. Giannobile has received numerous awards from the AAP including the Robinson Regeneration Award, Clinical Research Award and the Distinguished Scientist Award from the American Academy of Periodontology for his research contributions to the field. He is a diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology and practices in Ann Arbor, Michigan.
